

# Board and Train



Our board and train program at Far Fetched Acres focuses on positive, gentle and science-based dog training.

Our board and train program is tailored to your individual dog's needs, with your training goals in mind. Your dog will be worked with throughout the day in regular solo training sessions and amongst the larger group. Our program includes enrichment feeding, our Mind Yer Manners service, and personalized quality time. In addition, your pup will participate in the full camp experience, including play rotations, daily grooming/body checks, complimentary exit bath and more!

Your dog will be sent home with a follow up training packet and information on how to reinforce his/her new skills.

It is important to realize that a week or two of training lays a foundation for your dog's new skills. These behaviors required continued practice and honing. That transition to a consistent daily routine at home is critical to the success of continued learning and understanding for your pup.

As part of the package, our trainer will schedule a follow up session in your home to demonstrate your pup's new skills and teach YOU how to keep up & continue to improve on your pup's training.

We often recommend that a dog receives additional private lessons where YOU continue to learn to work with and train your pup too!

## **Our program is best suited for the basics of obedience which includes:**

- Coming when called
- Sit, Down, Stay, Leave it, Look
- Structured Socialization
- Impulse Control - Jumping, waiting patiently
- House Training
- Crate Training

## **Our program is not suited for:**

- Aggression cases of any sort are not suitable at Far Fetched Acres. The environment at Far Fetched Acres is geared toward dog to dog and dog to human socialization. It would be unfair to our other campers to take on any dog to dog aggression cases. In terms of dog to human aggression, it is best to address these issues in your home and in your routine environment where the dog needs to learn to exhibit new desired behavior. We can refer you to a trainer in NYC.
- City specific issues that we cannot recreate up here - sensitivity to sound, on leash dog to dog aggression/excitement
- Resource guarding - becoming aggressive over food dishes, toys, or territory.
- Separation Anxiety

In order to avoid charges for private training sessions or waiving the board and train follow up session, all cancellations must be received by the company/your trainer 24 hours in advance.
